Aim of MarTERA

- › To strengthen the European Research Area (ERA) in maritime and marine technologies as well as Blue Growth
- › Focus of development given to technologies (instead of sectors)
- › Large impact to a wide range of application fields
- › To bring industry and research actors across borders together will strengthen Europe's economic position

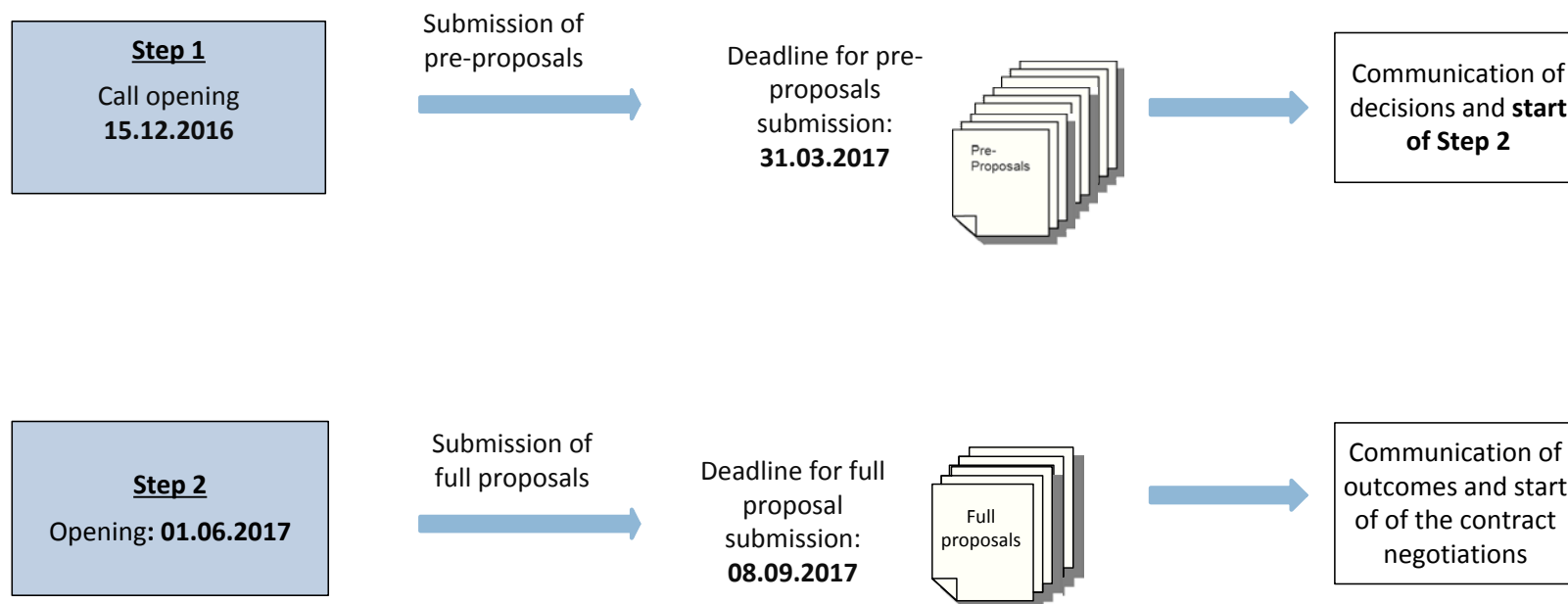
MarTERA project

- › 18 Ministries and funding organisations participating
- › Duration: 5 years
- › Co-funded call in 2017 with about 30 Mio. €
- › Deadline for submission foreseen: **31.03.2017**
- › Further calls for 2019, 2020, 2021

MarTERA project: Co-funded Call

- › 5 Priority Areas fixed in cooperation with the partners and JPI Oceans
 - › **Priority Area 1:** Environmentally friendly maritime technologies
 - › **Priority Area 2:** Development of novel materials and structures
 - › **Priority Area 3:** Sensors, automation, monitoring and observations
 - › **Priority Area 4:** Advanced manufacturing and production
 - › **Priority Area 5:** Safety and security

Call Process: 2 step procedure



Participating countries

- › **European Member States:** Belgium (Flanders), France, Germany, Ireland, Italy, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Spain,
- › **Associated countries:** Norway and Turkey
- › **Third countries:** Argentina, Belarus and South Africa

MarTERA Call criteria

- › Proposed project must relate to one of the topics/sub-topics in the Priority Area Matrix
- › The project proposals should involve industry.
- › At least **two independent eligible legal entities** from **two different European Member States** or **associated countries**
 - › Legal entities/consortia from Argentina, Belarus and South Africa: at least **two independent eligible legal entities** from at least **two different European Member States** or **associated countries**

MarTERA Call criteria

- › The proposal should be novel and not correspond with on-going or completed projects funded by other instruments, programmes or projects.
- › Requested funding range 1 to 2 Mio € per project
- › The total amount of funding requested from a funding organisation in a proposal may not be higher than the available budget for this organisation.


MarTERA Call criteria

- › Project duration: 36 months
- › Pre-proposal and the full proposal must be submitted correctly and completely before the respective deadlines via the MarTERA Submission Tool (www.martera.eu)
- › Proposal must be written in English

Pre-proposal submission

- › The pre-proposal consists of different parts which have to be filled in online.
- › Please note that you can save your text only if it does not contain more characters than pre-defined within the submission tool.

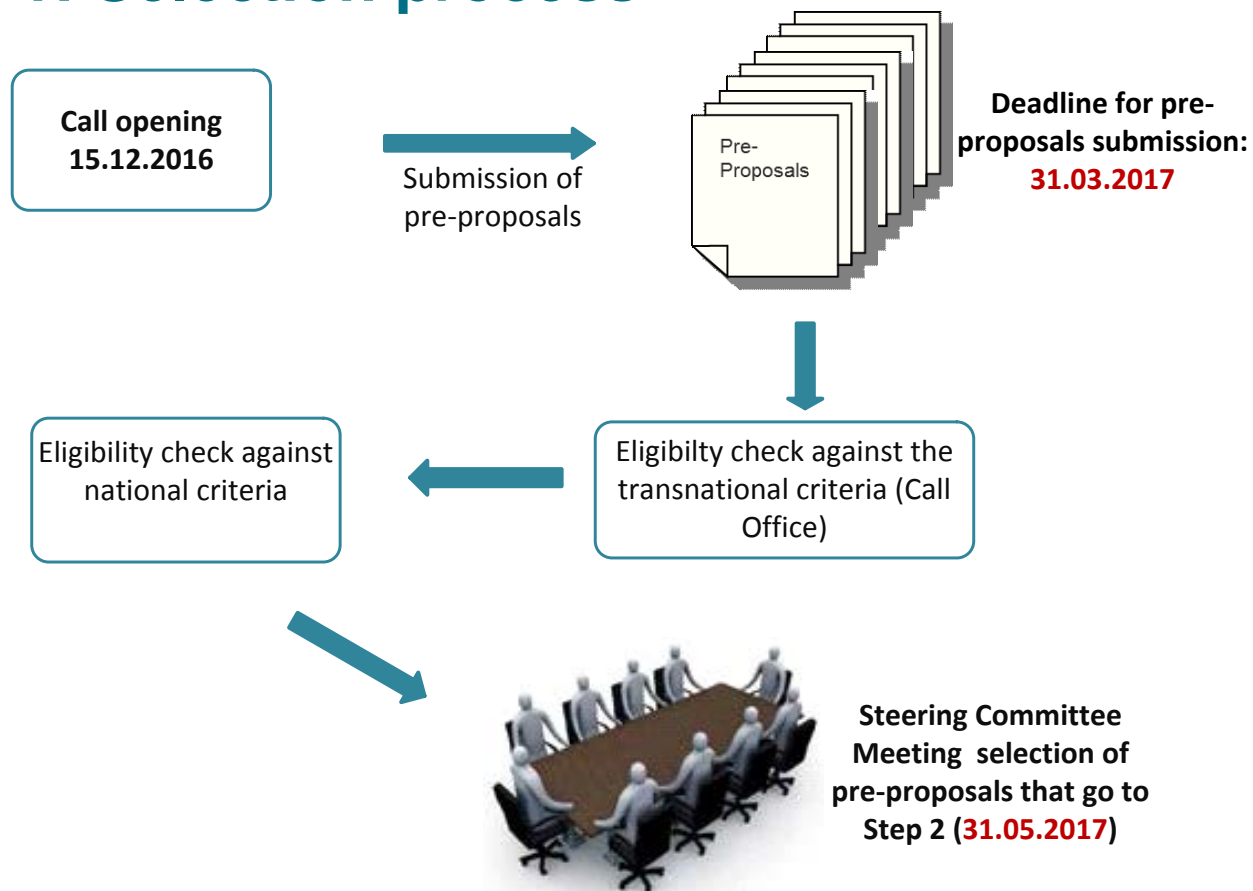
Content pre-proposal

- › PROJECT OBJECTIVES summary, general objectives of the project (strategic, commercial, etc.), scientific and/or technological aims of the project, relevance to the scientific scope
- › STATE OF THE ART in research and development, earlier research activities and experience of partners in the proposed field etc.
- › EXPLOITATION PLAN economic and scientific advantage/expectations and potential of the project (commercialisation of results, potential IPR, etc.)
- › ADDED VALUE European added value in carrying the work at European level

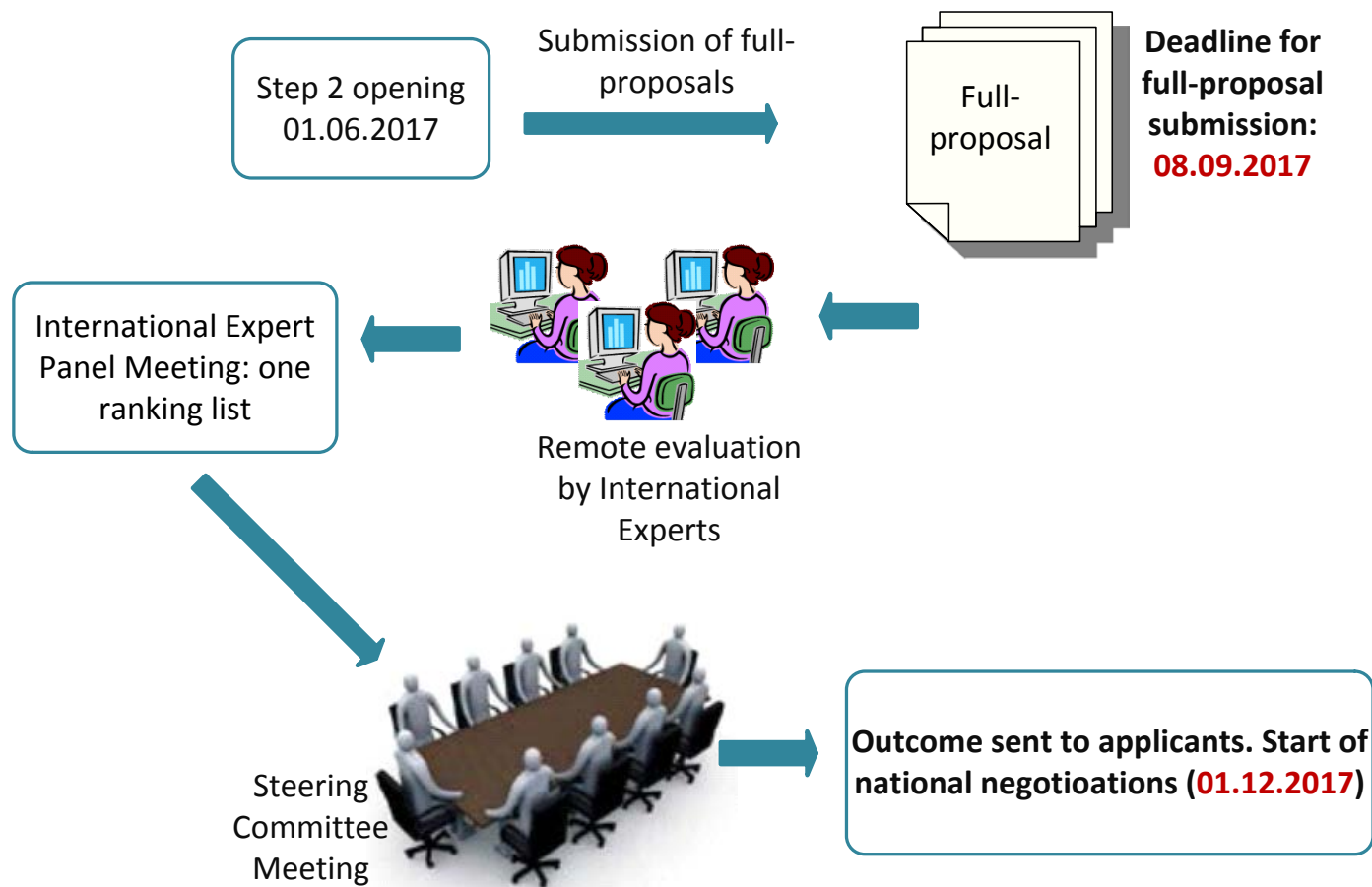
Content pre-proposal

- › FUNDING AND RISK necessity for funding and risk, scientific and technological risks, investigations with a risky character
- › WORKPLAN: methodology, research design, first work plan details
- › CONSORTIUM COMPOSITION: describe the consortium partners and the necessity of cooperation
- › FINANCIAL PLAN: personnel, travel, material and equipment, consumables, other costs like subcontracts, depreciation and rent/leasing, overheads requested funding, total own contribution, total costs
 - › some types of costs may not be fundable by all funding organisations

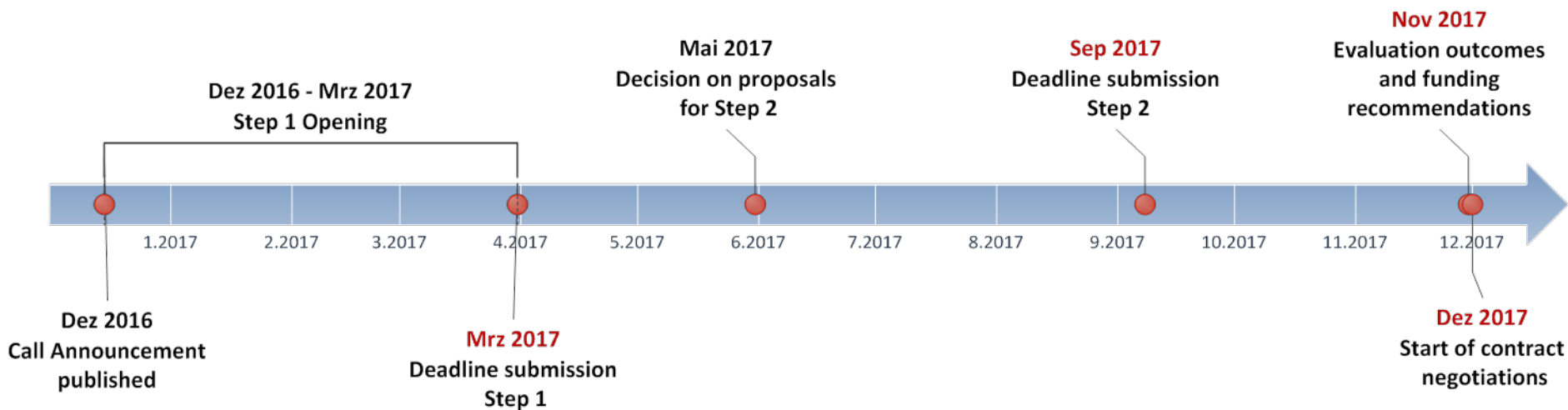
Step 1: Selection process
